What will happen during the meeting?

The event will start with a short presentation about the aim of YPAG and activities we hope the group will carry out, followed by a Q&A session. After that there will be a coffee break (refreshments will be served).

After the break we will have some small group discussions and activities. We will do our best to ensure that everyone participating is included, listened to and can have their say. Please note that this will be restricted to participants, but if your parent(s)/carer(s) are coming with you they are welcome to stay at the waiting room in College during this time.

After the small-group activities there will be time to talk to us 1:1 in case you still have questions or anything you'd like to discuss.

How can I contribute to the meeting?

Talk about your opinions and experiences. Everyone at the meeting will have different views and ideas; people will be encouraged to share these, but also to listen to each other. We want to know your views, we do not expect you to be an expert about research.

Who will be there?

Young people from different schools and backgrounds who are interested in joining the group. We expect about 30 participants altogether.

Do I need to do anything to prepare?

Reading this will probably be enough – you may want to make a note of any questions that you may have beforehand, but don't feel like you *need* to ask questions.

Will there be parking space available?

Yes, Wolfson College has ample on-site parking. It is free of charge and no permit is necessary.

Can you cover my travel costs?

We are able to cover reasonable transport costs. If you'd like to claim your expenses, please email the bank sort code and account number to info@begoodeie.com ahead of the meeting. Bring bus/train receipts with you on the day and we will process the expense forms at the end of the meeting. Please note that you will not receive any other form of reimbursement for attending this meeting.

We will email you a few days after the meeting to let you know the final outcome of your application. At that point we hope you will have a better idea of what YPAG involves and will be able to tell us whether or not you wish to join.
